Ha dado conferencias y publicado documentos sobre la interpretación, separación de poderes, ética judicial, independencia del poder judicial, laicidad, derechos sociales, negacionismo y hate speech. Fue consultora del Consejo de Europa, visiting scholar en la Facultad de Derecho de Yale, visiting professor en la Facultad de Derecho de la Universidad de Tel Aviv y visiting professor en el Käte Hamburger Center de Bonn. Actualmente es coordinadora científica del proyecto europeo (2019-2021) Boosting Competences in Penitentiary Staff in Europe (JUST area).

Professor of Public Comparative Law at the Law Department of Università della Campania, where she is the Dean's delegate for students with disabilities and specific learning disorders. Her research interests lie mainly in comparative constitutional law and theory. She has lectured and written on legal interpretation, separation of powers, judicial ethics, independence of the judiciary, secularism, social rights and hate speech. She was a legal expert for the Council of Europe, visiting scholar at the Yale Law School, visiting professor at the Faculty of Law-Tel Aviv University, and visiting professor at the Käte Hamburger Center in Bonn.
